
El Triangle


Bulevard Rosa


Maremagnum

It's surrounded by popular attractions like the Aquarium and the Imax Port Vell (IMAX cinema). Inside the center, you'll find a huge selection of fashion retailers and souvenir shops along with leisure activities and numerous restaurants, ice cream parlors and fast-foods outlets. On the upper floors there are popular bars, clubs and discos that attract a large following of young people. The best way to get here is to walk from Plaça de Colom on the modern wooden bridge (Moll de la Fusta) over the water, which can be raised to allow boats to pass.


