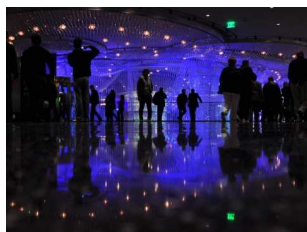

Rhubarb

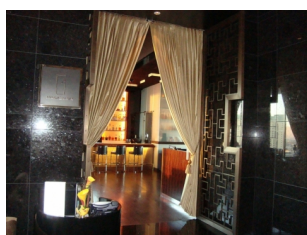
"Caribbean Inspired Cocktail Bar"

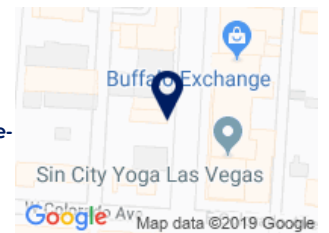

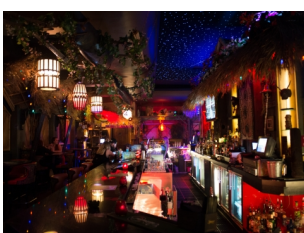

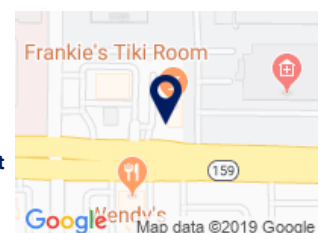
